

Welsh Government Learning Grant for Further Education Personal Details Evidence

Use the information below to find out what documents you need to send us to confirm your details. You should send **photocopies** of your evidence unless otherwise stated. We will return any original documents.

If you hold a valid UK passport, enter these details on the application form. This means you don't need to send your UK passport to us.

Proof of your identity or your age

Send us:

- Your valid UK passport details as requested in section 5 of the application form; or
- Your valid non-UK passport, national identity card, Biometric Residence permit or card details as requested in section 5 of the application form; or
- Your original birth/adoption certificate.

If your name has changed from the one shown on your documents, you'll need to also send us proof of your name change, this can be either:

- Your **original** marriage certificate; or
- An **original** deed poll.

Proof of your current marital status

We need proof of your new status.

If you're now separated, send us:

- your **conditional** order; or
- a letter from your solicitor confirming your status.

If you're now divorced, send us:

- your decree absolute; or
- your final order; or
- your dissolution order; or
- a letter from your solicitor confirming your status.

If you're civil partnership dissolved, send us:

- your conditional order; or
- your final order; or
- your dissolution order; or
- a letter from your solicitor confirming your status.

If you're now married, send us:

- your **original** marriage certificate.

If you're now in a civil partnership, send us:

- your **original** civil partnership certificate.

Living with a partner

If you're now living with a partner but have been divorced/separated/widowed or have had your civil partnership dissolved, send us the relevant evidence listed above.
