Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) Third Party Evidence

You need to prove that you are legally able to act as a third party for the EMA applicant. Use the information below to find out what you need to send.

We will accept photocopies of your evidence.

If you're:

acting on behalf of a student who is not capable of:

completing/signing the application form

and/or

 holding a bank or building society account in their own name

You need to send:

• documentation from a public body (for example your Local Authority) or a Power of Attorney confirming that you are authorised to act and/or accept payments on the student's behalf.

Examples include:

- a statement of the student's special educational needs; or
- a letter showing you receive Disability Living Allowance (DLA); or
- a letter showing Personal Independence Payments (PIP) on behalf of the student.
